COMPANY CONTRACT (Parents Keep)

Please read the contract thoroughly before you sign. Once your child has made a company, you must have this signed in order for your child to participate. It states everything you will be required to uphold during the year. Our Company is time consuming and takes a great deal of commitment. Be sure that you are ready to take on this commitment. 1st and last months tuition will be due with a registration fee of \$50.00 when you sign up for the classes for the year.

COMPANY GROUPS

We are looking forward to the new season. Below is some of the things that will be required for each Company.

Pre-Company: These dancers will learn 1 to 2 numbers during their rehearsal time. They will compete in 3 competitions, Nexus and Spotlight, and Team Dance. They will be at the studio one night a week.

Company 1: These dancers will learn 3 dances. One during the summer, and the others during company rehearsal time. They will compete at 3 competitions, Nexus and Spotlight, and Team Dance. They will also attend two conventions: TBA. They will be at the studio 2 nights a week. There is also the possibility of extra rehearsal time outside of the set rehearsal time during the week.

Company 2: These dancers will learn 3 dances. One during the summer, and the others during company rehearsal time. They will compete at 3 competitions, Nexus and Spotlight, and Team Dance. They will also attend two conventions: TBA. They will be at the studio 2 nights a week. There is also the possibility of extra rehearsal time outside of the set rehearsal time during the week.

Company 3: These dancers will learn 4 dances. One during the summer, and the others during company rehearsal time. They will attend 3- 4 competitions and also attend 3-4 conventions, with 2 possibly out of town. They will be at the studio 3 nights a week. There is also the possibility of extra rehearsal time outside of the set rehearsal time during the week.

Company 4: These dancers will learn 4 dances. One during the summer, and the others during company rehearsal time. They will attend 3- 4 competitions and also attend 3-4 conventions, with 2 possibly out of town. They will be at the studio 3 nights a week. There is also the possibility of extra rehearsal time outside of the set rehearsal time during the week.

Verge: These dancers will learn 3 to 4 dances and create a community piece. During the summer, they will work on their community piece and learn 2 dances. They will attend 3 to 4 competitions and 3 to 4 conventions.

Other company performances: Festival of Trees(Nov), Winter Parade(Dec), Winter Recital(Dec), PNW (March), HS Dance Team Spring Shows(April and May), EDP Final Recital(May).

For Verge: Community Piece Performances, Boys and Girls Club classes, Verge Recital(May).

TUITION

All prices cover tuition for the required classes.

Students can add the following at registration:

Tuition is due on the 1st of every month. Payments not made by the first week of the month will be assessed a late fee of \$10.00 and class privileges will be suspended until the situation is corrected. This affects everyone on the team so please, if there is a problem with a payment, please let us know immediately. There will also be a \$25.00 return check fee. If you want to set up automatic credit card withdrawal, there will be a \$5 fee per month. If accounts are past due 90 days, there will be a 5% late fee on the past due account balance. There will be an additional 5% late fee each month thereafter on the past due balance.

REGISTRATION FEES

All company members must pay the registration fee of \$50.00 per family, which reserves your place in class, and includes a professional DVD recording of the Recital in May.

ADDITIONAL COMPANY FEES

You will be required to pay costume fees, choreography fees, convention fees and competition fees as well as the tuition. We will give you an estimated list of all the fees. There will be no refunds on payments that have already been made.

Company members travel costs will include a portion of the studio owners airfare and hotel. For example; if both owners travel to Portland with the Companies, and 30 Company members attend, the cost of airfare and hotel for both owners are totaled, then divided by 30.

Example: Airfare = \$120.00 round trip x 2 people = \$240.00
 Hotel = \$55.00 per night x 2 people x 2 nights = \$220.00
 \$240.00 + \$220.00 = \$460.00, divided by 30 = \$15.33 per Company member

ATTENDANCE POLICY

A student may miss a total of 5 rehearsals for whatever reason. Rehearsals are the classes where you work on your routines. If you miss 5 rehearsals, team privileges will be suspended until a meeting with member and parents can be arranged.

You may not miss the practice before the performance for any reason. That is the day we will make sure everything is ready to go for the performance. If you miss the practice before a competition, you will not perform even if you have paid your fees (and fees will not be refunded). There is 1 exception on this policy-a school event where a grade is at stake. If you give us at least 2 weeks notice, we will call an extra rehearsal, which everyone must attend, that will serve as the practice before the performance.

Being a member of a company, it is your responsibility, if you have missed a class, that you learn the material that was covered before you come back to the following class. Remember, being a company member is a big commitment, and it affects everyone if you have missed multiple classes. If you know that you will not be able to attend a class, please call the office and let someone know or email us at least 2 weeks prior to the missed class. If your child has an illness, please call the studio to let us know that your child will not be attending that day.

If you want to participate in solo/duo/trio's for competition, please make sure that you are aware of the costs and time involved. Elevated Dance Project wants to produce quality pieces because it affects everyone involved with the studio. If you have not spent the time cleaning and preparing for competition, we may not let you participate. If you decide to do a solo/duo/or trio, please let either Kim Machado or Melissa Larson know. If you decide to use our facility to learn or practice your routines there will be a one time charge of \$100.00 for the full year, you are able to use the studio at any time there is no dance classes. Please let either Kim or Melissa know when you are planning on using the studio. We must approve of your routine before you are able to compete the routine. We will retain the rights of each routine performed or competed by EDP Students.

SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

Please be aware that being a company member will take a lot of time and commitment! If you are planning on participating in other school or extra-curricular activities, please know that you need to put Elevated Dance Company first. If there is a conflict, (other than those activities that you will be graded on) please make a decision between the two activities. We have noticed in the past when students participate in more than one activity, their grades tend to drop. We want our students to have a quality education and still be able to participate with our Companies.

SUMMER SESSIONS

Company members will be required to participate in the summer sessions at Elevated Dance Project. If you have already planned on taking at either Summer Dance Fest or Twin Falls Camp, and feel that you are not available to take one of the summer sessions, please talk with Kim or Melissa. We will determine if you are excused from the session. These sessions are not only to keep up the technique and dance during the summer but also bring the students closer together as a team.

OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS

Remember you are always representing Elevated Dance Project and there will be no Drug/Alcohol/or Tobacco use. If we find out that these have been used, you will be terminated from the group. You need to be healthy and physically fit, and we want our dancers to feel good about themselves, and have energy during classes. Make sure to incorporate a healthy diet, stay hydrated, and get plenty of rest!

This is a one-year commitment and if you feel that you are not able to fulfill that commitment due to any circumstance, this may not be the right decision for you.

Parents must also understand that they are representing Elevated Dance Project and we will not tolerate any misconduct. We feel that this community is too small to make enemies and if you have a strong feeling about something please make sure that you are aware of your surroundings. The best place to voice those opinions is in your own home. We want the atmosphere of Elevated Dance Project to be positive, and also supportive of other studios, even if we may not agree. If you have any complaints or problems, please go directly to one of the owners. We can only address problems that we know of, and the fastest way to solve a problem is good communication.

If students have a period of time between classes and are not picked up during that time, they must wait in the studio quietly. They may eat a snack, do homework, etc. but no running around the building. Students must also wait inside the lobby to be picked up, as we want to ensure the safety of our students. Students must be picked up no later than 10 minutes after their class has ended.

DRESS CODE

Students must be dressed accordingly to each class; no baggy clothes, proper shoes, and hair out of face. For all ballet classes you must wear leotard and tights, and hair needs to be tight to your head. You will also need ballet shoes. It is up to the teachers' discretion to excuse a student from class due to improper dress. Parents maybe called if your child is not properly dressed.

CELL PHONES

Cell phones will not be allowed during class time. If they have a break during class they are allowed to use them. If student uses their cell phones during class time, they will be taken away for the rest of the night until the student is done.

SPONSORS

Each company member is able to get sponsors for the season. You are allowed to get as many sponsors as you can. 10% of the money from the sponsor will be held for production of advertising for that sponsor. You must turn in your sponsor forms by the end of December.

EMAIL

We constantly communicate through email, and it is very important that we have a current email address for each account. Check your email frequently for messages from EDP, and make sure you read them thoroughly. We also suggest you set a folder for all the email coming in from EDP. There will be many!
